Program Overview

Campus Life ministry combines healthy relationships with creative programs to help young people make good choices, establish a solid foundation for life, and positively impact their schools. Campus Life directors work with local teachers, counselors, administrators, youth pastors and parents in hopes of developing positive support networks for young people.

Position Overview

- Recruit, train, and empower volunteer teams that will fulfil the mission of Youth for Christ with students (typically 11-19).
- Form partnerships with other youth serving organizations, churches, schools and businesses to provide opportunities for students.
- Create a Community Support Team, that helps solicit the necessary community and financial support for the ministry. This position does require a portion of personal and community fund-raising.

Additional Information

- Schedule is flexible and non-traditional, based around access to the facilities, volunteer availability and youth availability.
- Day and multi-day trips are required periodically.

Requirements

Youth for Christ is a Christian faith-based, 501c3 organization that requires all staff to be actively living out their Christian faith and committed to a local church body.

- A Bachelor's Degree or relevant work experience
- Experience in building and leading teams
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Ability to manage multiple priorities concurrently
- Basic computer and office software skills
- Ability to maintain a flexible work schedule
